Policy on administration of Medicine.

We at Laser will administer medicine with parental consent ***however - only if essential***

GJBaily, JABrooker and others are trained in administering epi-pens.

Insulin dependent diabetics will have each individual case discussed with parents by WM and GJB. There is no policy for exclusion of such a disorder but appropriate management of sugar levels will be monitored safely.

There is a form that must be completed for any medication brought onto camp informing staff of procedures if necessary.

Parents must sign this form to give permission for the medicine to be administered.

We aim to enable regular attendance and are fully inclusive so far as is our ability as a summer camp, however if the medication that is needed is for a serious illness, or something that could be classed as infectious – please see our Policy on infectious children.

Managing medication on trips and outings -

When planning offsite activities - (see form), the group leader and manager will make sure that any prescribed medication is taken with the child off-site.

This will be taken into account as part of our risk assessment.

If the child needs medication for an activity that might affect their illness or need to take the medication – parents will be consulted by GJB to discuss the implications and risk.

GJB's decision is final on participation.

Parents must again sign a form for this to be administered.
